#### Vision

- The purpose of HEMIS Foundation is to:
  - Explain the nature and scope of the South African Higher Education Management System (HEMIS) and
  - Locate it in the broader South African Higher Education context.



#### **HEMIS** Institute

- The purpose of HEMIS Institute is to:
  - Discuss and workshop HEMIS related issues,
  - Engage with officials of the DHET and the CHE on aspects impacting on HEMIS,
  - Cover various aspects of statutory reporting, and
  - Develop skills in the area of statutory reporting.



### Institutional Research Workshop (IR)

- The IR is aimed primarily at:
  - Introducing Institutional research to staff
    members at institutions of HE in Southern Africa
    who are relatively new to the practice of IR,
  - Managing information that institutions of HE gather for their own planning and management purposes, and the data they provide to Government.



## Quality Institute (QI)

- The purpose of QI is mainly aimed at:
  - A general introduction to the practice of quality assurance (QA) in HE,
  - Consider better practice and benchmarking in the area of QA, and
  - Share valuable experience gained over time.



#### **SAAIR Conference**

 SAAIR hosts an annual conference which is probably Southern Africa's largest gathering of higher education professionals working in IR, assessment, planning, and related postsecondary education fields. The conference features presentations by delegates representing all sectors of higher education and accommodates exhibit stalls that feature some of the latest tools and resources supporting data use and decision making.

 The scholarship programme provides an opportunity for young Institutional Research (IR) staff to develop their skills and knowledge as practitioners supporting decision making in Higher Education. Scholarships assist staff to attend the annual SAAIR Conference.


